

RELAY RACE

RELAY RACE IN THE INTERNATIONAL FIREMEN'S STAR TOURNAMENT, GYULA 2009

Place: Gyula - Lake in front of the castle and the surrounding environment.

Participation rate: Each team is made up of three persons.

Number of obstacles: The race requires the completion of five 5 obstacle-tasks.

Description of the event

First team member, "A", runs with a fire-hose and thrust nozzle in his hand through the steps, located at variable distances on the 4 m long ladder laid down on the ground (obstacle 1). After leaving the ladder, the relay happens while handing over the nozzle. (After the relay is completed, the runner "A" gets into the boat.)

Second team member, "B", takes the hose and the nozzle from racer "A" and picks up into his hands two buckets (full with 5 liters of water) and runs in a slaloms style among seven columns (obstacle 2). After the last column he puts the buckets down. Thereafter, he hands over the hose and nozzle in the relay zone to the "C" team member. (After the hand over, "B" gets into the boat as well.)

Third team member, "C" crawls through the pipe (4 m long, 70 cm of diameter) positioned on the field (obstacle 3). Thereafter, he too has to get into the boat in which the team members "A" and "B" wait for him. They have to row across to a designated point on the other shore (obstacle 4). (The hose and nozzle is still at the racer "C")

After getting out of the boat, the three members, "A", "B" and "C" have to climb up the ladder which is leaning against the castle's wall where they accomplish the last obstacle. Team member "A" has to fill up by any possible small buckets a 20 liter portable sprayer, butt hose. Team member "B" pumps up the sprayer while member "C" aims and sprays to a target with a 5cm diameter hole and fills the 1 liter container behind the hole with water (obstacle 5). The mission is accomplished when the team rises up the nozzle.

Timekeeping: manual time keeping, from the start signal to the rising of the nozzle

Disqualification: missing the obstacles, losing of the nozzle, or not meeting the maximum time requirement.

Maximum time: 6 minutes

Categories: **adult** (born before 01.01.1991)
junior (born after 01.01.1991)

Attendance-fee: **15 euro/team in adult category**
12 euro/team in junior category
